7. The Queen has visited Africa.

Has the Queen visited Africa? (question Present Perfect)

**Has** *a jury* **listened** to the group? (question Present Perfect)

10. The children have bought ice creams.

**Have** the children **bought** ice creams? (question Present Perfect)
